Syrian Visa Procedures

Regular Visa

Individuals traveling on their own should hold Syrian visa on their passport prior to arrival. Travelers without a valid visa may have their entry denied at the border.

Tourist Visa

To ease the issuance of a visa for tourists entering Syria, Concerned authorities in Syria has issued a new regulation. From one person and over, for a tour arranged by a travel agency in their country and organized by a licensed Syrian travel agent. By obtaining a security clearance in advanced (10 - 45 days depends on the nationality), Visas are issued upon arrival for almost all nationalities (restriction is for some Asian and African countries). Please refer to us for more information.

Tourist visas are delivered at any Syrian border. For Groups, A detailed Passport Manifest should include the following information: First and family name, father's first name, date and place of birth, passport number, passport expiry date, profession, nationality.

Travelers entering Syria with a passport Manifest should arrive and depart together. If one or more persons plan to quit Syria on a different date or from a different border than the rest of the group, a separated Passport Manifest should be issued.

The passport list, drawn up on agency's papers with header, should be faxed or e-mailed to us before arrival. Five original copies of the passport list should be brought with the "group". All copies should be stamped and signed. Passports should be valid for minimum 6 months after departure date. **Passports should not bear any Israeli stamps.**

For Groups visa formalities, the presence of our assigned guide on arrival and departure is mandatory.



Jordan Visa Law & Policy

According to the Jordanian law (June, 2015) any passenger traveling alone or as a part of a group carrying a **European or any other non-restricted passport** can obtain an entry visa on arrival at any border point of Jordan except when less than 5 pax entering from Allenby Bridge (in which case it is necessary obtain their visa before arrival, from the country of origin). Visa for Europeans and non-restricted nationalities, is free of charge if and when staying in the country at least 48 hours/2 consecutive nights and have booked touristic services with a local tour operator. A manifest should be completed and submitted with passport details for each client with a scanned passport copy, and sent to our offices at least 72 hours prior to arrival.

When passengers entering Jordan through Arava Border, a permission needs to be issued by the local authorities in Aqaba in advance, which again requires a manifest to be completed and submitted to our offices at least 15 days prior to arrival. The procedure fees is 20JOD / 30USD.

The validity of the passport must exceed 6 months from departure date.

Other Nationalities:

- Please check in your country of origin at the Embassy or Consulate and obtain a visa before travelling.
- Anyone leaving Jordan through land borders needs to pay an exit fee of 10JOD (approx. 15USD)



Lebanon Visa Policy

Regular Visa

Individuals traveling on their own should hold Lebanese visa on their passport prior to arrival. Travelers without a valid visa may have their entry denied at the border. Except for Europeans, American, UK citizens and some other nationalities can get the Visa upon arrival at the airport or Border. Please refer to us for more information.

Group Collective Visa

To ease the issuance of a visa for tourists entering Lebanon, concerned authorities in Lebanon has issued a new regulation. From eight person and over, for a tour arranged by a travel agency in their country and organized by a licensed Lebanese travel agent. By obtaining a security clearance in advanced (7 - 15 days depends on the nationality), Visas are issued upon arrival for almost all nationalities. Please refer to us for more information.

For Groups, A detailed Passport Manifest should include the following information: First and family name, father's first name, date and place of birth, passport number, passport expiry date, profession, nationality.

Travelers entering Lebanon with a passport Manifest should arrive and depart together. If one or more persons plan to quit Lebanon on a different date or from a different border than the rest of the group, a separated Passport Manifest should be issued.

The passport list, drawn up on agency's papers with header, should be faxed or e-mailed to us before arrival. All copies should be stamped and signed. Passports should be valid for minimum 6 months after departure date. **Passports should not bear any Israeli stamps.**

For Groups visa formalities, the presence of our assigned guide on arrival and departure is mandatory.

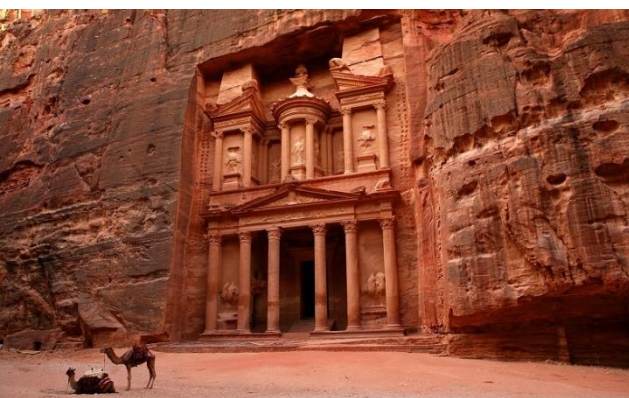

Herod the Great, king of Judaea used it in the 1st century BC as health treatment. The water and the special conditions of the area have positive effects on dermatological and rheumatic diseases. Free time at leisure. Dinner and overnight

DAY 07: DEAD SEA – BETHANY – DEAD SEA

Breakfast and departure for the border with Israel and Palestine, in search of the Jordan River. We will dedicate this day to visit one of the most mystical and spiritual places in Jordan. We visit Bethany, the place where Jesus was baptized by St. John the Evangelist. The Jordanian enclave of Bethany was opened to visitors in 2000 and Pope John Paul II attended its inauguration as a sign of its recognition by the Vatican. Place of the Baptism of Jesus "Bethany beyond the Jordan" (Al-Maghtas) The archaeological complex located on the eastern bank of the Jordan River, about 9 km north of the Dead Sea, is of immense importance for Christianity because it is recognized as the place where Jesus of Nazareth was baptized by ohn the Baptist.
