York city pass valid for one day giving you free entry to 26 City Centre attractions plus pizza or pasta at ASK.




York & beyond explorer pass, choose from 2, 3 or 6 days giving you entry to your choice of any of the 50 attractions.

York is blessed with a compact city centre allowing you to dip between designer stores, unique boutiques, big high street names and friendly market stalls whilst visiting the city. With a backdrop that includes medieval lanes and even a street that dates back to the Domesday Book, this is not your average retail destination. Hit the streets and weave in and out of York's shops and stores.

The historic backdrop of York's charming city centre provides an inviting location to explore and even discover boutiques and retail gems. Stonegate and Swinegate are home to a mix of stores such as Stonegate Teddy Bears, Pyramid Gallery, Abraham Moon and the ever festive Käthe Wohlfahrt each housed within medieval and Georgian architecture. Follow the route towards York Minster and discover more retail treats and expert advice on Petergate at the diamond experts Bradleys and fellow jewellers Azendi.

Parliament Street, Davygate and Coney Street are packed with high street favourites such as M&S, Space NK and Leia. This focal point of the city also enjoys visiting festivals, events and street entertainers. Similarly Coppergate, the city's shopping centre within the city walls, which is situated on the site of a Viking village also hosts recognisable names. The centre is home to firm favourite, Fenwick and the bargain hunter's mecca, Primark.





